ICHRPI Statutes – 2025 (Extracts)

§ 7: Organs of the association and Direction

The organs of the association are:

- a) the General Assembly
- b) the President and the Vice Presidents
- c) the Secretary-General
- d) the Treasurer
- e) the Director of Publications
- f) the National Conveners
- g) the Auditors

(...)

§ 10: Direction

(...)

The Direction shall consists of

- the President and at least six but not more than ten Vice-Presidents
- the Secretary-General and, if appointed, the Under-Secretary-General
- the Treasurer
- the Director of Publications
- up to four additional members (“Advisors”), and

(by invitation and without voting rights) the Editor of the journal *Parliaments, Estates & Representation*.

With the exception of the Editor, all members of the Direction are elected by the General Assembly for a four-year term. Members of the Direction may be re-elected, the President, however, not more than once. (...)

Nomination for election as a member of the Direction shall require the written endorsement of at least four members from more than one country and the prior written consent of the person concerned. Emails and digital signatures shall be acceptable means of giving consent for this purpose.

§ 14: Auditors

The General Assembly elects two Auditors for a four-year term. Their re-election is permitted. The Auditors may not belong to any other organ of ICHRPI, with the exception of the General Assembly.
